
Resources for Aspiring Writers



MOTIVATION

COMPETITIONS OR SUBMISSIONS

Look for **local** (libraries, writer's groups) or national competitions to participate in to motivate yourself to write on a smaller scale (and without much at stake) towards a deadline.

MAKE A HABIT

Look for learning opportunities online or through your local library.

PLATFORM

WEBSITE

The digital world expects a digital presence. Think about how you might brand your work or yourself as an author professionally.

GoDaddy - Allows you to purchase your website domain name before someone else nabs it. As your site gets traffic the value goes up. Don't forget to renew and be in danger of losing your valuable brand name! https://www.godaddy.com (There are several other ICANN registrars to purchase a domain name from.)

Wix - Offers a <u>free</u> entry-level membership that can be graduated up as needed. They also offer templates, apps and functions to those who don't know about website coding. https://www.wix.com You can also pay someone to create/maintain your website for you.

RELATIONSHIPS

Form relationships with readers, libraries, bookstore owners, and other writers through writing groups before you publish.

SOCIAL MEDIA


Shoot for the best professional look possible. Always think of your digital presence in a professional light. Always be sure to thoroughly study the legalese on copyright and restrictions for any photo, graphic, or video usage.

Canva - You can make many promotional graphics using templates on Canva. They offer <u>free</u> and premium membership levels. (They also did have a data breach recently.) https://www.canva.com/join/raisin-homely-length

Facebook - You'll need to set up a personal page and then an author page that hangs off of that personal profile (using Create, Page, Artist/Band/Public Figure). Research what settings to use for the author page that best suit your needs, including who sees your information. www.facebook.com

BUSINESS LICENSING

If you choose to set up a business for self-publishing (which does grant additional protections), check with your state's business licensing entity, the IRS, and your city (if required).

LIBRARY OF CONGRESS

You will need to change your password with the Library of Congress (PrePub Book Link) site at their prescribed interval to avoid losing access to your account. As an additional copyright protection, you can register with the Library of Congress site for a control number for each book title prior to publication. Include this control number on your copyright page. https://library.id=auth_home

PUBLISHING

POD (Print-On-Demand) & eBooks

Print-on-demand makes self-publishing very affordable for the new author. No need to invest in a huge stack of books. eBooks bring in a significantly lower income, so price wisely. Remember that there will be a cut from the print service, as well as a percentage from the bookseller. Your royalty will be the remainder and will not be paid immediately.

KDP (Formerly CreateSpace; Amazon company) KDP will **not** pay royalties to any authors under the age of 18 at this time, so you can either wait until you turn 18, or work out the setup to pay royalties (and file tax info) under your parent/guardian's SS#. This would affect their taxable income, and have other implications for your platform.

ISBN

Bowker is the ONLY source for your ISBNs, if you want to have the most freedom with how/where you publish. ISBNs are NOT free, and the best pricing will be in bulk. KDP (Amazon) does offer free ISBNs for your titles, **but** you will be tied to their restrictions forever. http://www.myidentifiers.com

IMAGES/COVER DESIGN

Be careful with copyright restrictions and attribution requirements!

Unsplash - The internet's source of <u>freely</u> usable images. The provide information on how to credit the source, as well as an opportunity to tip them. https://unsplash.com

Pixabay - <u>Free</u> images and royalty-free stock, but there are restrictions. Check the specifics for each image/ video you wish to use. https://pixabay.com

PNG Tree - 2-image daily download limit for <u>free</u>. Images may require attribution. <u>https://pngtree.com</u>
